

THE WEST AUSTRALIAN ABORIGINAL CHILD HEALTH SURVEY: PRICING POLICY

TELETHON INSTITUTE FOR CHILD HEALTH RESEARCH

1.0 PREAMBLE

This document summarises the fees that apply to the range of products and services available from the West Australian Aboriginal Child Health Survey (WAACHS). The survey is a project of the Kulunga Research Network at the Telethon Institute for Child Health Research (the Institute). The Institute, via the Kulunga Research Network, is the steward of the data collected.

The conditions that govern the release of information from the survey are stipulated in the WAACHS *Access to Information Policy*, which should be read in conjunction with this document.

2.0 SCOPE

This pricing policy covers the following products and services:

- Printed publications and other material
- Customised analyses of WAACHS datasets by WAACHS custodians on behalf of external clients
- Supervised access to WAACHS unit record files in a data laboratory environment.

3.0 PRICES

Prices for all products and services have been developed on a cost recovery basis.

3.1 Official publications

The recommended retail prices (RRP) of the suite of WAACHS volumes are as follows:

3.2 Customised tables

Prices have been set on a cost recovery basis and will be charged based on the time taken for WAACHS custodians to generate and validate requested data tables.

The standard price for this service is \$105 per hour.

A discount rate is available for Masters and PhD students enrolled at an Australian university, Institute of technology or TAFE. As a guide, a fee of \$40 per hour will apply, although the final quoted price will depend on the size of the request and the desired turnaround time.

3.3 Supervised access to unit record files

Prices have been set on a cost recovery basis. The service is inclusive of:

- enabling access to WAACHS confidentialised unit record files;
- training clients to use the WAACHS interface; and
- supervising clients to access the confidentialised unit record files.

A single flat fee of \$110 per hour applies to the use of this service.

A discount rate is available for Masters and PhD students enrolled at an Australian university, Institute of technology or TAFE. A price will be quoted upon request.

WAACHS	The West Australian Aboriginal Child Health Survey
Institute	The Telethon Institute for Child Health Research.
Kulunga Research Network	The formal partnership agreement between the Telethon Institute for Child Health Research and the Western Australian Community Controlled Health Organisations
Data	Items recorded in the survey and stored in electronic form in the WAACHS databases
Information	Data processed to produce meaningful information, e.g. text, tables, charts, reports
Unit record data	Data which relates to a specific unit of data collection, e.g. individual, household or school level information
